### Our galleries and experiences

#### **Te Waka Theatre**

An epic widescreen animation taking you aboard a Polynesian voyaging canoe on the first great journey of migration to Aotearoa.

#### **Landfalls**

Navigate the pioneering voyages of discovery, settlement and trade that colonized New Zealand and the Pacific. Learn about the ocean as a lifeline for a small archipelago at the bottom of the world, as the youngest country on Earth arrives onto the global stage.

#### **New Beginnings**

Take a journey in the rocking cabin with the 'Immigrants', people who left their homeland between the 1840's and the 1960's to come to live in New Zealand. This area also includes the historic Ferries Gallery and Whaling Gallery, snapshots of our maritime past.

#### **Blue Water Black Magic - A Tribute to Sir Peter Blake**

A journey through New Zealand's proud history of yachting, design innovation and competitive success. The exhibition commemorates the remarkable life and work of Sir Peter Blake, and also tells the stories of many other key players in New Zealand's yachting industry. This area has many hands on activities that are both educational and fun!

#### **Edmiston Art Gallery**

New Zealand's finest collection of maritime art expressing the spirit of a seafaring nation. With changing exhibitions this gallery always has new art works to discover!



#### **Kiwis and the Coast**

As an island nation surrounded by the world's largest body of water, our intrinsic bond with the ocean has shaped the evolution of the Kiwi identity. Explore the broad and varied elements of New Zealand society resulting from this dynamic relationship with our coastal environment.

#### **Heritage Vessel Fleet**

Voyager possesses one of the world's few working fleets of heritage vessels. Enjoy a unique experience on the sparkling Waitemata Harbour aboard one of them - Ted Ashby, Breeze or SS Puke. Many others vessels such as super yachts or current America's Cup racing yachts can be viewed from our harbour side observation windows.
