Programme Overview

Set amongst our galleries your students will take part in a fully programmed timetable including:

An Educator-led workshop where students will discover heroes of New Zealand including Kupe, Captain Cook, sporting heroes, surf life-savers, and Sir Peter Blake.

Beginning in Te Waka your students and their whanau will be challenged to explore their concept of what heroes are. They will be inspired to be daring and recognise their own or others heroic moments.

A self-guided trail to discover other heroes of the sea in our galleries. Working in small groups led by their adult supervisor your student will be challenged to consider if these people or organisations are heroes.
