Auckland A changing landscape

The landscape of Auckland's main harbour has changed significantly since the arrival of the first people. How has it changed over time? What factors have influenced those changes? How will it change in the future? What are some issues related to these changes?

Students experience a full day of activities with unique access to Museum Collection images of the harbour from the past.

Programme Overview

Set amongst our galleries and the CBD your students will take part in a pre-negotiated programme that may include some of the following according to your needs:

Educator-led workshop—students will discover the many changes to the waterfront with our NZ classroom trained educators. They will learn about changes from the past and present, and consider future changes. They will reflect on the many issues involved in changing a landscape.

Ted Ashby Harbour Sailing—students will enjoy viewing the waterfront from the water where they will use images from the Museum Collection to support their learning **subject to availability*

Optional- Waterfront Treasure Hunt students will discover the waterfront on this self-guided adventure. This will include a stop in at the Karanga Plaza Kiosk where they can discover the future plans for Auckland's waterfront.

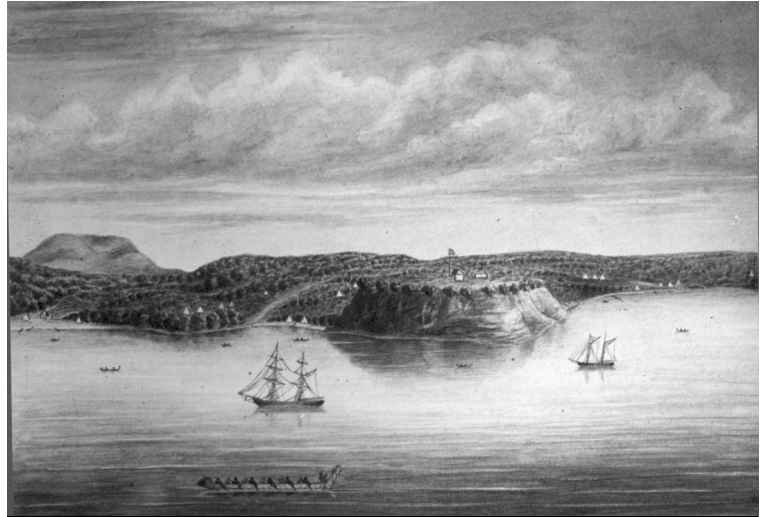
