Water safety education has never been so much fun!

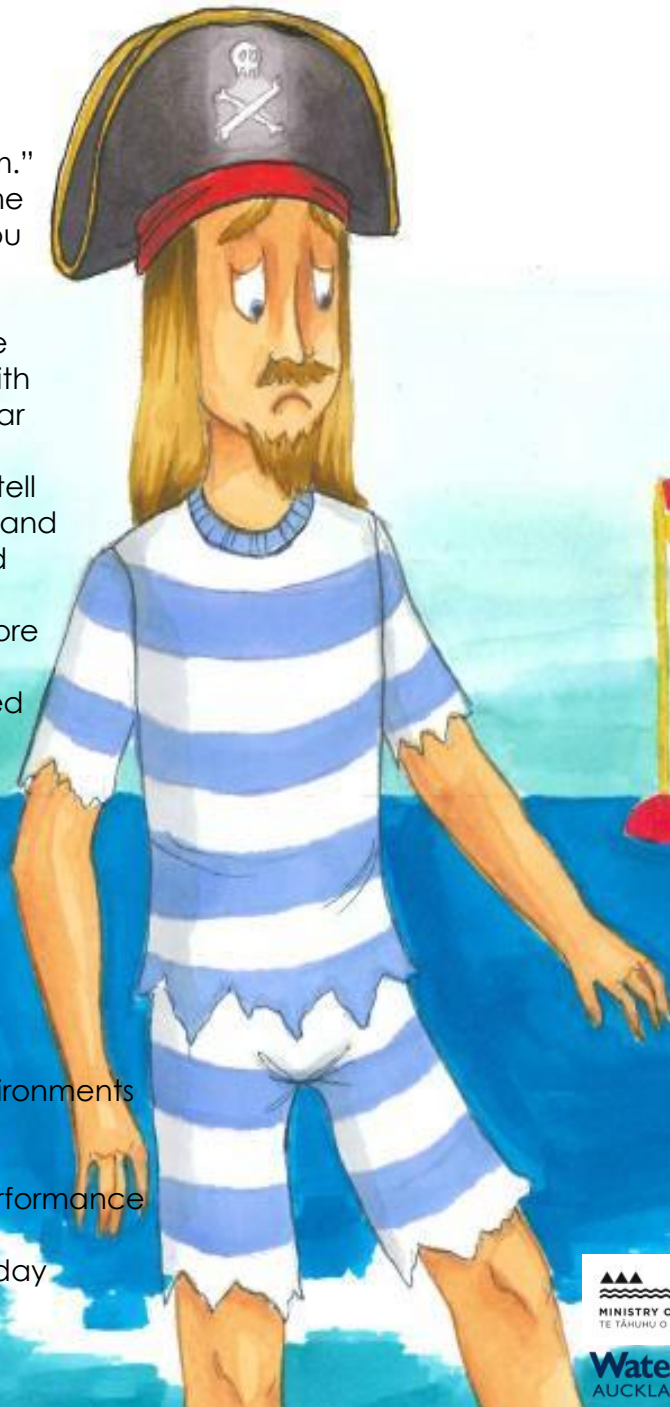
Experience the much-loved, interactive performance "The Pirate That Couldn't Swim." We make it easy for you. This show can come to you or you can come to the Museum- you choose.
